Senator Young convened the meeting at 1:30 p.m.

(1) Testimony

Senator Young recognized Brad Ray, Ph.D. to describe the evaluation that he is performing on the Recovery Works Program (Exhibits 1 and 2). He indicated that there has been an increase in supportive service from Recovery Works and stated that earlier research (on Indiana's Access to Recovery program) suggests that the most successful programs for promoting re-entry and recovery for convicted felons address the barriers of returning inmates who participate in these programs as well as mental health or substance use problems. One of the significant barriers to successful re-entry identified in the Recovery Works evaluation was the lack of housing.

(2) Consideration of Legislative Proposals and Final Report

The Committee examined the information provided in Exhibits 3 and 4 when reviewing the draft of the final report. After discussion, the Committee recommended adoption of PD 3317 and PD 3318.

After further discussion, the committee approved the final report by a vote of 10 in favor and 3 opposed.

Senator Young adjourned the meeting at 3:40 p.m.
